**CITY LIGHTS TELEVISION RECIEVES FOUR
NEW YORK EMMY® NOMINATIONS**

New York, NY (February 13, 2007) - City Lights Television, one of New York City's largest production companies and a corridor of City Lights Media Group, was awarded four New York Emmy® nominations from The New York Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. The 50th Annual New York Emmy® Award nominations took place on February 8th at the studios of CUNY-TV.

City Lights Television took home three nominations for its entertainment programming and one for its Health/Science material. Dave Noll, President of City Lights Television and City Lights Digital, executive produced all the nominated episodes.

Nominated shows include: "Walking with Johnny," about the life and music of Johnny Cash (produced for MagRack; Executive Produced by Dave Noll and Christopher Stout, produced by Ali Mansfield); "Inner Chef" and "Party Girl" (produced for Discovery Home; Executive Produced

by Irad Eyal and Dave Noll, Series Producer Marla Puccetti); and "Fit Family" (produced for Fit TV; Executive Produced by Irad Eyal and Dave Noll, produced by Dylan Edgar).

"Last year, we produced over 200 episodes of television, up from just 26 the year before," said Noll. "And these nominated series spanned genres from Music to Cooking to Fitness. You don't have this consistent quality of work without immensely talented producers, editors and crew. This is really a testament to the entire City Lights team."
